SIXTEENTH
AMENDED
STANDING ORDER

In the interest of public health and safety, and after consideration of public health guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, New York State, New York City, Westchester County, and other public health authorities, the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York hereby orders that, effective immediately, the Fifteenth Amended Standing Order, dated September 7, 2022, is hereby rescinded. There are currently no restrictions on entry to the courthouses relating to COVID-19 diagnosis, symptoms or exposure, although persons who are ill are encouraged to take appropriate precautions and all persons are asked to be respectful of others' choices of protective measures. Individuals must continue to abide by any COVID-19-related restrictions implemented by any judicial officer in a courtroom or its adjacent areas (e.g., robing room, jury deliberation room).
