

LAW CLERK AND INTERN HIRING INFORMATION
Lewis J. Liman, United States District Judge

CLERKSHIP APPLICATIONS

Positions: Judge Liman has completed law clerk hiring through 2026-2027. He has openings for one-year clerkships commencing in the summer and fall of 2027 and thereafter.

Application Timing: Judge Liman is currently participating in the Law Clerk Hiring Plan and, accordingly, will not consider applications from students graduating in 2026 until June 9, 2025. Applicants graduating in 2025 or who graduated earlier may apply at any time.

Application Process: Judge Liman does not accept paper applications. Applicants should apply through OSCAR. Applications should contain a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, undergraduate transcript, writing sample, and three letters of recommendation.

Clerkship applicants should visit Judge Liman's profile on OSCAR for updated information regarding vacancies and other hiring information.

INTERNSHIP APPLICATIONS

Positions: Judge Liman has completed law intern hiring through summer 2025 and is no longer accepting applications for that term. Judge Liman hires a limited number of interns each summer and each spring/fall semester. The position is unpaid.

Application Timing: Prospective summer interns may apply beginning in December of the preceding calendar year. Applications from first-year law students should generally contain their first-semester grades. Applications for each spring/fall term are reviewed on a rolling basis in the months preceding the internship.

Application Process: Interested applicants should submit a cover letter, resume, law school transcript, and short writing sample to LimanNYSDCambers@nysd.uscourts.gov.
